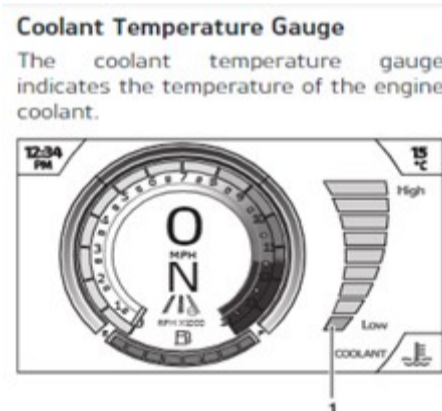

RECALL NOTICE - SPEED TRIPLE 1200 RS & RR

The release of TOL Ref. #23287-SVC reflected a draft version of the intended release which contained errors. The information has been corrected dealerships should use this notice related to the recall.

Please note that Triumph Motorcycles Limited is currently preparing to launch a recall on model year 2022 and 2023 Speed Triple 1200 RS and RR models. An additional heat shield will now be added to the radiator fan. The heat shield will protect the radiator fan and prevent the fan motor from seizing. We expect to launch this campaign over the coming days.

Please reassure any owners that may contact you between now and the recall launch. Riders are advised to monitor their instrumentation when operating the vehicle as normal. If overheating is registered, the Owner handbook advice should be followed as shown below.



1. Coolant temperature gauge

When the engine is started from cold, the coolant temperature gauge will show empty gauge segments. As the temperature increases more gauge segments will be shown full. When the engine is started from hot, the coolant temperature gauge will show the relevant number of full gauge segments, dependant on engine temperature.

The normal temperature range is between the Low and High on the coolant temperature gauge.

With the engine running, if the engine coolant temperature becomes dangerously high, the high coolant temperature warning light will illuminate in the warning light location and a warning message will be shown.

Triumph is working hard to improve the recall launch date and we will re-contact you with an update as soon as we are able to do so.

For vehicles in dealer stock, the safety recall MUST be actioned before delivery to the customer.
