

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

AUTOCAR, LLC ACX-2301 NHTSA RECALL NO. 23V018

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Autocar, LLC has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in 206, 2021-2023 model year Xpeditor (ACX) chassis manufactured between January 5, 2021, and September 19, 2022, with nonsequential serial numbers in the range of 235088 through 241053. Accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective February 22, 2023.
