## **New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 63A**

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2022 Model Year (DT) Ram 1500 vehicles.

## REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may be equipped with a trailer reverse steering control module ("TRSCM") that prevents the rearview image from displaying under certain conditions.

Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard ("FMVSS") No. 571.111 S6.2.6 requires that "The rear visibility system default to the rearview image being visible and meet the requirements of FMVSS No. 571.111 S6.2.1 (field of view) and S6.2.2 (image size) at the beginning of each backing event, regardless of any modifications to the field of view that the driver had previously selected." Suspect vehicles may not display the rearview image during a backing event under certain conditions.

The vehicle operator will notice that the rearview image is not displayed if attempting to reference the image while backing. If this warning is not heeded, backing without verifying it is safe to do so could lead to an increased risk of injury to people outside the vehicle.

## **SERVICE ACTION**

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to update the TRSCM software. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2023.
