**SAFETY RECALL NOTICE** On February 10, 2023, Daimler Truck North America ("DTNA") filed a Defect Information Report ("DIR") with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration ("NHTSA") and a Defect Information Notice ("DIN") with Transport Canada ("TC") informing the agencies of our intent to conduct a voluntary safety recall.

Until further instructions are available, vehicles subject to this "Stop Delivery Order" must be held and not be delivered to customers.

#### **Affected Vehicles:**

### **Problem:**

On the affected vehicles the brake modulator valves on the front axle may corrode, which during a braking event initiated by Electronic Stability Control (ESC) or Roll Stability Control (RSC) may result in full system pressure applied to one front wheel end causing a brake pull differential in braking force. A full system pressure applied to one front wheel end could lead to a brake pull resulting in a sudden change in vehicle direction due to uneven braking on the front axle increasing the risk of a crash.

### Solution:

Daimler Truck is currently validating the final repair and securing replacement parts. Repairs will be performed by Daimler Truck North America authorized service facilities, at no charge to the vehicle owner.

# **IMPORTANT NOTE:**

Dealers should make their personnel aware of this safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer
