Advance Notice - Compliance Recall 50G5 / Safety Certification Label

Issue:

The certification label on the subject vehicles indicate incorrect values for the Gross Axle Weight Rating ("GAWR"), resulting in a failure to comply with regulatory requirements. An incorrect GAWR can result in the vehicle being overloaded, increasing the risk of a crash

Precautions:

In the interim, until this recall remedy has been completed, owners should not rely on the GAWR information printed on the vehicle's Safety Certification label. The correct rear axle GAWR for the affected vehicles is: 3902 lbs / 1770 kg.

Repair:

- REPAIR NOT YET AVAILABLE
- Check daily campaign open inventory report or OMD for affected vehicles in inventory.
- Audi is working to make a recall remedy available as soon as possible for the affected vehicles. Dealers and owners will be notified in writing once the recall remedy work can be performed.

By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

<u>Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:</u> Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
