Re: Stop Sale/Safety Recall: 2023 CR-V Front Passenger Seat Frame

On February 16, 2023, American Honda notified NHTSA of a **stop sale** and **safety recall** for 98model year 2023 CR-V units due to improper manufacturing of the front passenger seat-back frame. In the event of a collision, the seat may not be able to properly restrain the occupant, increasing the risk of injury. **Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.** 

Failure to repair a vehicle as necessary prior to sale may subject your dealership to claims or lawsuits.

### **BACKGROUND**

During manufacturing, a small number of front passenger seat-back frames may have been improperly welded on one side. An improperly welded seat frame may not hold the seat in position during a collision preventing the occupant from being properly restrained.

## **REPAIR**

Replace the front passenger seat-back frame.

## **PARTS**

Parts are available through the normal parts ordering system.

## **TOOLS**

There are no special tools needed for this recall.

### **SERVICE BULLETIN**

Service Bulletin 23-018, Safety Recall: 2023 CR-V Front Passenger Seat Frame has posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of February 17, 2023. It includes parts, repair, and warranty information related to this recall.

## **CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION**

American Honda expects to begin customer notification by the end of March 2023.
