The adhesion of the front fixed panel to the vehicle body might deteriorate gradually over time and could result in the front fixed panel partially or fully detaching from the vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash and/or injury for other road users. When the issue occurs, the customer might observe a partially detached front panel or wind noises in the area of the sunroof while driving. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will replace the front fixed panel on the affected vehicle.

#### Prior to performing this Campaign:

- VMI must always be checked before performing campaigns to verify that the campaign is required on a specific vehicle. Always check for any other open campaigns, and perform accordingly.
