Code requires this wire to be capped and terminated inside of a junction box. This wire was capped using a Wago connector but not terminated inside of a junction box.

0	The condition was corrected when production re-implemented the installation of the junction box for the air conditioner "prep wire" for Basecamps manufactured without the optional rooftop air conditioner.
