Description of the Defect: The side stand springs retaining pin on the side stand bracket could wear out

and in extreme cases could break, causing the side stand to open when it is in

the raised position.

Description of the Safety Risk: If the side stand open during the motorcycle riding, the side stand sensor will

switch off the motorbike engine increasing the risk of crash and injury.

Description of the Cause: NR

Identification of Any Warning If the side stand springs retaining pin on the side stand bracket break, the side that can Occur: stand would not remain in the raised position and remains in the open, so the rider may notice that the springs do not keep the side stand in the raised position or when the rider starts his motorbike, when he engages the gear, the side stand switch will switch off the engine.

#### **Chronology:**

On September 14, 2022, Ducati Motor Holding received the first report from the network about a motorcycle with the side stand springs retaining pin on the side stand bracket broken with consequential engine stalling.

On October 2022 the case has been escalated to the Ducati Motor Holding's pre-internal safety commission. Warranty and customer contact records were reviewed and analyzed.

On December 2022 the case has been escalated to the Ducati Motor Holding's internal safety commission while the side stand bracket with the springs retaining pin broken was analyzed by the internal laboratory.

On January 2023, has been started a constant and detailed monitoring of the field report.

During the monitoring above, Ducati Motor Holding become aware of a total of 18 reports about motorcycle with the side stand springs retaining pin on the side stand bracket broken; none of these reports came from USA. Neither injuries, nor property damaged were reported in these cases.

On September 05, 2023, Ducati Motor Holding's internal safety commission decided to launch a recall

campaign to affected bike park.

No injuries or property damaged have been reported.
