This is to notify you of the new Recall Campaign to inspect the 12V starter/alternator wiring harness on <u>5,326</u> Model Year ("MY") 2022-2023 SL (232 platform) vehicles. The recall campaign will be visible on the www.NHTSA.gov website and may generate questions from customers. Affected VINs will be flagged in VMI as "PENDING" on October 13, 2023.						
	Background					
Issue What We're Doing		Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year ("MY") 2022-2023 SL (232 platform) vehicles with the M177 engine, the routing of the 12V starter/alternator wiring harness might not meet specifications. The wiring harness might contact the drive shaft and chafe, which may result in a short circuit. A loss of propulsion cannot be ruled out which could increase the risk of a crash. Additionally, due to the high electrical currents potentially flowing through this wiring harness, the temperature in this area might increase. Therefore, a risk of fire cannot be ruled out. MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will inspect and secure the 12V-starter/alternator wiring harness on the affected vehicles.
