Under certain conditions, the permanent OBD fault code memory of the 48V ISG control unit may not activate. An authorized Mercedes- Benz dealer will update the software in the affected vehicles.

Prior to performing this Recall Campaign:

- VMI must always be checked before performing campaigns to verify that the campaign is required on a specific vehicle. Always check for any other open campaigns, and perform accordingly.
