## **New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – R30061715**

FCA US LLC announced a safety recall on certain 2001 through 2005 model year (ST) Chrysler Sebring and Dodge Stratus vehicles.

Some of the above vehicles may have interference between the passenger side sun visor and the passenger side airbag during an airbag deployment event with the sun visor in the lowered position. Depending on the downward angle of the sun visor, the force of the airbag could detach the sun visor from its mount, propelling it rearward towards the passenger seat. This could increase the risk of injury front seat passengers during an airbag deployment.

FCA will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all involved vehicles to install a tether strap to the passenger side sun visor.

Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established methods used in the past.

We ask that you please take the time to ensure that your personnel are aware of this communication and are prepared to execute a customer friendly process for inquiries on involved vehicles.
