## **New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – U38**

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2004 through 2007 model year (KJ) Jeep<sub>®</sub> Liberty vehicles.

VINs identified as being involved in this campaign are currently live and searchable.

## **REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL**

Some of the above vehicles' rear suspension lower control arms may experience excessive corrosion and could eventually break. A broken rear control arm could cause reduced vehicle control and may cause a crash without prior warning.

## **SERVICE ACTION**

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the rear right and left side suspension lower control arms. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2018.
