



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – U43

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2018 model year (LX) Chrysler 300, (LD) Dodge Charger, (LA) Dodge Challenger, (WK) Jeep® Grand Cherokee, (WD) Dodge Durango, (JL) Jeep® Wrangler, (DS) RAM 1500 Pickup vehicles equipped with an 8-Speed Automatic Transmission.

VINs identified as being involved in this campaign are currently live and searchable.
Stop sale is in effect for the above-identified vehicles.

IMPORTANT: Some of the involved vehicles may be in dealer new vehicle inventory. Federal law requires you to complete this recall service on these vehicles before retail delivery. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to \$21,000 per vehicle. Involved vehicles can be determined by using the VIP inquiry process.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with an incorrect park rod. An incorrect park rod in the transmission may not allow the vehicle to reach the mechanical “PARK” position although the gear select indicator may display the “PARK” position. **A loss of “PARK” may lead to vehicle rollaway, and may result in a vehicle crash or injury without prior warning.**

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the transmission park rod. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2018.

We ask that you please take the time to ensure that your personnel are aware of this communication and are prepared to execute a customer friendly process for inquiries regarding involved vehicles.
