In the course of continuous product monitoring and internal tests, Automobili Lamborghini S.p.A. has determined that in rare cases, the stainless steel screws fixing the brake rotor to the metal bell may fail due to stress corrosion cracking if the vehicle has been used in extreme salt environments. This may lead to a increase in stopping distance and could lead to a crash.

Your vehicle is one of the models affected.

If one of the affected screws fails, you will hear a noise upon braking, indicating this condition.

Please contact an authorized Lamborghini Dealer or Service Point without delay to arrange an appointment. Please bring this letter and your Service Booklet with you when you visit the dealer, so that we can make all necessary entries.

We will replace the screws free of charge in the estimated time of 3 working hours that may require you to leave your car at least 1 business day at the workshop.
