This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Porsche has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2015 Porsche 918 Spyder vehicles. Our records show that you are the owner of a vehicle affected by this action.

What is the issue?

Porsche has made the determination that, due to a component manufacturing error, there is a possibility that the durability of the lower control arms of the front axle cannot be guaranteed over the service life of the vehicle.

A fracture of a lower control arm while the vehicle is being driven increases the risk of a crash. Because of this safety concern, we strongly recommend that the vehicle not be driven until the recall remedy is completed.

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

What will we do?

Porsche is conducting a safety recall on these vehicles. The lower trailing arms for the front axle on your 2015 Porsche 918 Spyder will be replaced by Porsche technicians at the authorized Porsche dealership of your choice. Of course, these repairs will be completed at no charge to you.

What should you do?

Porsche Cars North America will also assist you in making contact with your authorized Porsche dealership to schedule a repair appointment as well as to arrange in advance for a Porsche loaner vehicle should you require alternate transportation from now until the completion of the repair. Once your vehicle is received at the authorized Porsche dealership, the actual repairs will approximately 11 hours to complete.

Lease vehicles and address changes

If you are the lessor and registered owner of the vehicle identified in this action, the law requires you to forward this letter immediately via first-class mail to the lessee within (10) days of receipt. If you have changed your address or sold the vehicle, please fill out the enclosed prepaid Owner Reply Card and mail it to us so we can update our records.
