- Your 2016 model year Nissan Frontier V6 is involved in a safety recall because the starter motor wire harness may be installed in an incorrect position, which could cause an electrical short to occur.
- Please schedule an appointment with your Nissan dealer immediately.
- This service will be performed for you at no charge.

OWNER NOTIFICATION

Dear Nissan Frontier V6 Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Nissan has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in some Model Year 2016 Nissan Frontier V6 vehicles. Our records indicate that you own or lease the Nissan vehicle identified by the VIN on the inside of this notice.

Reason for Recall

The starter motor wire harness on your Model Year 2016 V6 Frontier may not have been installed properly. If this harness is not properly installed, it may create a short circuit and potentially cause a fire and risk of injury. To help prevent this from occurring, please contact your dealer immediately.

What Nissan Will Do

Your Nissan dealer will inspect the starter motor wire harness installation and reposition it if needed, at no cost to you. This should take less than an hour. Please note that your Nissan dealer may require your vehicle for a longer period of time based upon their work schedule.

What You Should Do

We urge you to contact your Nissan dealer immediately in order to arrange an appointment to have your vehicle inspected. Please bring this notice with you when you keep your service appointment.
