This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Porsche has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2017 model year Macan, Macan S, Macan GTS, and Macan Turbo vehicles. Our records show that you are the owner of a vehicle affected by this action.

What is the issue?

Porsche has determined that the front anti-roll bar of the affected vehicles may have been fitted with connecting links from a defective batch on which the connecting link bushings can move out of the connecting link eyes.

If the bushings move out of the bushing eyes, the vehicle's handling may be impaired, increasing the risk of a crash.

What will we do?

Porsche is conducting a safety recall on these vehicles. The connecting links on the front anti-roll bar will be inspected and, if necessary, replaced

free of charge.

What should you do?

Please contact your authorized Porsche dealership to schedule a repair appointment and to arrange in advance for a Porsche loaner vehicle should you require alternate transportation during the repair period.
