ISSUE

The windshield wiper pivots on some 2012 MKS vehicles built on or before 2/5/2012 may chafe the 14290 harness. Driveability symptoms may indicate this condition exists.

ACTION

Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove the cowl panel grill, refer to Workshop Manual (WSM), Section 501-02.
- 2. Inspect the 14290 harness for possible chaffing at the windshield wiper pivots.
 - a. If harness is not damaged, this article does not apply.
 - b. If harness is damaged at the wiper pivots proceed to Step 3.
- Repair harness damage following wiring repair guidelines found in the Wiring Diagrams cell 5-1.
- 4. Secure harness to the retention features in the cowl area. (Figure 1)

5. Install the cowl panel grill, refer to WSM, Section 501-02.
