## FORD:

2013-2014 Escape

# **ISSUE**

Some 2013-2014 Escape vehicles built on or before 9/13/2013 may exhibit loose attachment of the left or right rear door trim panel, typically near the bottom of the door. A new retaining clip is now available for service.

### <u>ACTION</u>

Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

### SERVICE PROCEDURE

- 1. Is the affected rear door trim panel damaged as a result of the loose attachment?




Figure 1 - Article 14-0004

  - a. Yes replace the rear door trim panel. Refer to Workshop Manual (WSM), Section 501-05. Use new style retaining clips on new door panel. (Figure 1) Repair is complete.

- b. No proceed to Step 2.
- 2. Remove the affected rear door trim panel. Refer to WSM, Section 501-05.
- 3. Remove the seven retaining clips from the rear door trim panel and discard.

- 4. Install the new retaining clips into the holes in the door trim panel.
  - a. When retaining clip is inserted in the correct position a clicking noise can be heard.
- 5. Install the rear door trim panel. Refer to WSM, Section 501-05.
