Some 2015 Mustang vehicles equipped with a 2.3L EcoBoost engine and built on or before 12/19/2014 may exhibit an illuminated MIL with one or more of the following diagnostic trouble codes (DTCs) P0036, P0054, P0137 and/or P0141.

ACTION

Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

- 1. Connect the Ford Integrated Diagnostic System (IDS) service tool or equivalent scan tool to the data link connector (DLC). Are DTCs P0036, P0054, P0137 and/or P0141 stored in powertrain control module (PCM)?
 - a. Yes replace the catalyst monitor sensor (CMS). Refer to Workshop Manual (WSM), Section 303-14.
 - b. No this article does not apply. Refer to Powertrain Control/Emission Diagnosis (PC/ED) manual for normal diagnosis.
- 2. Reprogram the PCM to the latest calibration using IDS release 95.01 or higher. Make sure you are connected to the internet when entering module programming to obtain the latest updates. Calibration files may also be obtained at www.motorcraftservice.com.
