ISSUE

Some 2015-2017 Mustang vehicles equipped with a manual transmission and built on or before 6/15/2016 may exhibit a no crank condition due to the clutch pedal position (CPP) switch being damaged.

ACTION

Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

- 1. Inspect the CPP switch for physical damage. Is the CPP switch damaged?
 - a. Yes proceed to Step 2.
 - b. No this article does not apply.




Figure 1 - Article 16-0103

- 2. Install a new CPP switch and bracket. Refer to Workshop Manual (WSM), Section 303-14. The switch includes a plastic bracket rotating the connector 90 degrees. (Figure 1)
