# Uncommanded Opening Of The Liftgate Window Glass - Built On Or Before 28-Jan-2018

Ford 2018 Expedition

**Issue:** Some 2018 Expedition vehicles built on or before 28-Jan-2018 may exhibit a liftgate window glass that opens uncommanded.

**Action:** Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

- 1. Is the vehicle built on or before 28-Jan-2018 and does it exhibit a liftgate window glass that opens uncommanded?
  - (1). Yes proceed to Step 2.
  - (2). No this article does not apply. Refer to Workshop Manual (WSM), Section 501-14 for normal diagnostics.

2. Install a new liftgate window glass release switch. Refer to the WSM, Section 501-14.
