This PI was superseded to add revised repair instructions. Please discard PIT5382B.

Condition/Concern

The customer may state that the Service Theft System message is/was on the Driver Information Center (DIC). Upon inspection, the technician may find that DTC B2955 is stored.

Recommendation/Instructions

Advise to inspect the connections at the immobilizer and ensure there is enough slack in the harness with the column extended. Verify there are no proximity passes or fobs (except GM RKE transmitter) on the key ring, if present, they should be removed. Reprogram the BCM with most recent calibrations.
