

TECHNICAL SERVICE BULLETIN 110V Power Outlet - High Pitched Buzzing/Ringing Noise With Engine Running From Right Side Front Interior

Issue: Some 2017-2018 Explorer vehicles equipped with a 110V power outlet may exhibit a high pitched buzzing or ringing noise from the right side front interior area while the engine is running.

Action: Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

Service Procedure

- **1.** With the engine running and nothing plugged into the 110V outlet, remove fuse F56 from the battery junction box (BJB). Is the noise still present?
 - (1). Yes this article does not apply. Refer to the Workshop Manual (WSM) for normal diagnosis.
 - (2). No proceed to step 2.
- 2. Replace the direct current/alternating current (DC/AC) inverter. Refer to WSM, Section 414-05.
