3.5L EcoBoost - Cold Start - Ticking/Tapping Or Rattle Type Noise - Built On Or Before 29-May-2015

This bulletin supersedes 16-0027. Reason for update: New Part/Procedure For Same Condition

Summary

This article supersedes TSB 16-0027 to update the Parts List.

Issue: Some 2011-2015 F-150 vehicles equipped with a 3.5L EcoBoost engine and built on or before 29-May-2015 may exhibit a ticking/tapping or rattle type noise from the top front cover area of the engine upon initial start-up lasting for 2-5 seconds after a cold soak of 6 hours or more.

Action: Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

- 1. Check the vehicle build date. Was the vehicle built on or before 29-May-2015?
 - (1). Yes proceed to Step 2.

- (2). No this procedure does not apply. Refer to Workshop Manual (WSM), Section 303-00 for normal diagnostics.
- **2.** Does the customer state a ticking/tapping or rattle type noise lasting for 2-5 seconds occurs from the top front cover area of the engine upon cold start-up after a cold soak of 6 hours or more?
 - (1). Yes proceed to Step 3.
 - (2). No this article does not apply. Refer to WSM, Section 303-00 for normal diagnostics.
- 3. Replace all 4 variable camshaft timing (VCT) units and the primary timing chain. Refer to WSM, Section 303-01.

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
