Correction:

Inspect IP harness at base of steering column, by the I-shaft. If the harness is chaffed, repair damaged wires and zip tie the harness away from the I-shaft.

Also Inspect the HVAC drain hose is properly routed and not plugged if water is leaking in to the BCM.

Also inspect for water intrusion at X200, X201, X500, X600, X700 and X800. Repair connector as needed and test for the water leak and repair.

Note: Customer may state they could not open the door.

Advised to look at their owner's manual.

To lock/unlock the doors from inside the vehicle: Pull once on the door handle to unlock the door and again to open the door.
