

Subject: Rear Air Conditioning Inoperative, Rear Air Temperature Doesn't Change When Commanded


Note: The technician may find the pivot for the temperature valve has pulled away from the actuator motor (2).

Verify if the temperature valve is working properly:

- If it has been validated that the rear temperature valve is not working properly, replace the A/C distributor case.
- If the temperature valve has been found to be working correctly, refer to SI for further diagnostics.

Important: Wiring harness length has the potential for the Upper DAT (1) and EAT (2) connectors to plug into the wrong sensor. To avoid mis-wiring the replacement case, you should mark each of the temperature sensor wires and note their location prior to removal. Confirm that the Purple/Black wire connector (3) goes to the Upper DAT, and the Gray/Black wire connector (4) goes to the EAT.

Replace the A/C distributor case. Refer to *Air Distributor Case Replacement* in SI.
