SUBJECT: Rear Gate Stay Warranty Extension

INTRODUCTION:

In the interest of customer satisfaction, Subaru of America, Inc. (SOA) is extending the New Car Limited Warranty for the rear gate stays on the above listed models and model years. The coverage period for the rear gate stays will be extended from the original three (3) years or thirty-six thousand (36,000) miles (whichever comes first) to eight (8) years (96 months) / one-hundred thousand (100,000) miles whichever comes first. All other terms and conditions of the original basic warranty coverage will continue to apply.

This change is in response to identified conditions which in some cases and under certain circumstances, may affect the operation of the rear gate stays. It also reflects SOA's commitment to providing Subaru customers with confidence in the function and overall performance of their vehicle. This warranty extension covers any internal or external failures such as, leakage, weakness, binding, seizure or other insufficient operation of the rear gate stays.

NOTE: <u>ALWAYS</u> perform a Vehicle Coverage Inquiry on Subarunet to determine eligibility for this warranty extension before proceeding with any inspection or repair. See sample inquiry result below.
