Condition	Some customers may notice during daylight conditions that the Daytime Running Lamps (DRL's) are not on and that the low beam headlamps are on. Upon further inspection, technicians may find a DTC B108E set for the Ambient Light Sensor signal.
Cause	The cause of this condition could be an issue with the BCM calibration.

Correction:

GM engineering has released new updated BCM calibrations to address this issue. To correct this condition, reprogram the BCM with the latest calibrations available in Service Programming Systems (SPS).
