APPLIED DATE:	Built before September 17, 2004

IF YOU CONFIRM:

A customer reports the following:

• The engine has low power, and/or the transmission doesn't shift (stays in 3rd gear).

and

The incident occurs just after the engine is started,

and

• When the engine is turned OFF then restarted, the engine and transmission return to normal operation,

NOTE: This incident, if it occurs, may also have the following DTC's stored in the A/T control unit (TCM). However, the MIL will not come ON (illuminate) for these DTC's.

- VHCL SPEED SEN-A/T (Vehicle Speed Sensor Automatic Transmission [Revolution] Sensor]
- VHCL SPEED SEN-MTR (Vehicle Speed Sensor-Meter)

ACTION:

Replace the A/T Control Module (TCM) with the new one listed in the parts information.

• Refer to section AT in the Service Manual (ESM) for replacement information.
